

- Is available by pressing the Chart Helper Caregiver Tool on the Room Kiosk



# Vital Signs Helper


## Basic Steps




- Caregiver presses the “Chart Helper” icon from the Room Kiosk
- Caregiver “Signs In” with their Unique ID and Passcode
- Vital Signs are located at the bottom of the Chart Code List
- Vital Signs screen will guide the Caregiver through capturing relevant information
  - The Caregiver will also be able to Copy & Amend the last reading
- Touch the “OK” button to generate a Chart Log for the room
- A summary of all logs can be viewed by the Room and the Nurses Station/Central Monitor



- The Vital Signs screen will guide the Caregiver to capture relevant information

- If prior Vital Signs were copied forward, they will be pre-populated and you can change or clear them as desired, otherwise all Vital Signs will start blank
- It is not required to enter values in all fields.
  - All are optional.

- It is not required to enter ADL Performance or Support for Vital Sign entries
- Vital Sign data is summarized into the Notes Section of this Chart Entry



# Vital Signs



- A Caregiver can pull up a running Chart Log for the room by selecting “Room Log” under Caregiver Tools.
